- Design of the memorial they're building as been adjusted: old design had serious dangers for pedestrians and cyclists alike.

Road works on Albert St (INB) – Michael Cahill

- Is there a suggested and a safe route for cyclists around the Albert St works for those who are traveling to Spring Hill from the Bicentennial Bikeway (via North Quay)?

- The bikeway crossing of North Quay is a pain (4 lanes of traffic) – what can be done?

Bicentennial Bikeway @ North Quay Ferry Terminal – Michael Cahill

- There's a barrier consisting of a simple metal pole that is sometime used to block cars from entering the bikeway at the NQ ferry terminal – should this be open or closed by default? When the pole is across the path, it can be hard to see – not visually distinct and also a lack of ambient light. Could be a nasty accident waiting to happen

Reflective armbands suggestion – Michael Cahill
