- Eleanor Schonell Bridge: lighting is being installed along the cycle path between bridge and Annerley Rd. barriers will remain up until this has been completed.
- Bicentennial bikeway: work has begun. There are some “cyclists dismount” signs on the ramp section between Cribb and Park Streets. BCC is seeking a resolution re cyclists on this matter. **ACTION: CBD BUG to send letter to project managers/owners (Jude Munro initially) requesting an explanation as to why the detour was not set up in the safest way in the first place, especially as this is a 3 year project.** JL asked us to hold off sending until BCC have resolved issue. CBD BUG declined.
- Wynnum Road cycle path: begins early May – night work. Project includes Hawthorne road to Canning Street Bridge.
