



Traffic Changes, Federation Street, Windsor

North-South Bypass Tunnel (NSBT)

Update to Residents & Businesses

On **Wednesday 2 April 2008**, stage two of the Federation Street realignment will be implemented.

Nightwork will occur from **6pm to approximately 11pm** and activities will include traffic signal adjustments, line marking and traffic barrier relocation.

The current work zone will be moved from the northern side of Federation Street to the southern side of Federation Street as shown on the map overleaf.

This work zone will be in place for approximately 8 weeks and work will include heavy earthwork and excavation with rockbreakers, laying new kerbs, channel and roadbase.

The following traffic changes will still be in place:

- Federation Street will remain a single outbound traffic lane
- No right turn from Lutwyche Road into Federation Street for traffic on the northbound lanes
- No left turn from Lutwyche Road into Federation Street for traffic on the southbound lanes
- Access to Federation/Bryden/Gallway/Morris Streets will be via Bryden Street, the new connection road and Gallway Street
- A U-Turn facility is available at the Lutwyche Road / Grantson Street intersection
- Pedestrian and cyclist access from Federation Street to Lutwyche Road will still be available and signage will be in place
- Bus stop 11 located at the corner of Federation Street and Lutwyche Road will remain open.
