



Pacific Motorway Bikeway Diversion, Woolloongabba North-South Bypass Tunnel

Advice to Cyclists

From Friday 27 April 2007, the Pacific Motorway bikeway between O'Keefe Street and Reis Street will temporarily close as part of the North-South Bypass Tunnel (NSBT) project. This stage of the bikeway detour will be in place until late 2007.

Cyclists will be diverted at O'Keefe Street to Ipswich Road along Albert Street, Elliot Street, Fleurs Street, Lockhart Street and back onto the bikeway. Directional signage will be in place to guide cyclists.

During the period of the detour there will be slight changes to the route including:

- Intermittent diversions from the eastern footpath on Ipswich Road
- Diversion around the construction area at the end of Lockhart Street
- Replacement of the Albert Street crossing to Burke Street
