### **BCC ATU – Scott Evans**

- Detours will be in place at Eagle St (bridge work) and near Admiralty Towers, disruptions during peak times have been minimized as much as possible.
- There may be more small interruptions near Admiralty Towers while they undergo maintenance work.
- Bike Theft signs are still being installed.
- Budget is around \$7 million for cycling in 07/08 for new bikeway and other infrastructure, with around \$1.5 million being bound for the CBD. The Budget papers are available on the BCC website, especially Schedules 6, 7, and 61, with some maintenance projects in 9. Also, some bike infrastructure is included as part of road upgrade projects, but not necessarily mentioned explicitly in the budget.
- Northern Link details: Scott will locate some maps and send them on to Paul M. There are two routes, one from the ICB to Pickering Street (Stage 3 being built in next 12 months) and along Lutwyche Rd. BCC Bike Maps are currently being updated and will reflect new routes. No date.
- Question: Article in newspaper mentioned that the Bowen Bridge Rd road bridge has concrete cancer and will require major work in the next 5 years – what chance is there that cycle facilities could be included in the work
  - o Answer: Needs some fairly strong community support for the facilities to be included, but is not impossible. Start lobbying now.
- Question: Construction barriers on Stanley St on the corner of Annerly Rd (near hospital) regularly intrude and block the bike lane for no apparent direct benefit for the work being carried out there, unnecessarily forcing bikes into heavy traffic. Is there a reason, or are construction crews exceeding the bounds of reasonableness.
  - o Answer: Scott will follow up

### **NSBT – Paul French, Aaron Wray, John Lister**

- South – no written report this week, no meeting. There have been minor alignment changes at the northern end of the current detour and the ramp to Lockhart St has been straightened, making the router easier and safer. Nothing new apart from that.
