

Bicentennial Bikeway upgrade – Stage 4



Temporary access changes

To maintain safety during construction:

- pedestrians must detour at Booth Street and Lang Parade at all times.
- access arrangements will be made and signposted for pedestrians wishing to access public transport. Please follow designated access routes and direction from traffic controllers where necessary.
- cyclists must detour at Booth Street and Lang Parade from 8pm to 5am and will be diverted onto a temporary side track from 5am to 8pm. Cyclist traffic will be limited to 10km/h when using the side track. Look for detour signage and follow the direction of traffic controllers where necessary. Alternate flow may be required along sections of the side track.
- Any additional detours will be notified via onsite signage.

The Bicentennial Bikeway is being upgraded progressively. Work will commence on the Bicentennial Bikeway – Stage 4 project in April 2014 and is expected to be completed mid 2015, weather permitting.

This project involves upgrading the section between the Land Street access tunnel and the bus stop to the west of the Regatta Ferry terminal. It includes 550m of pathway and 60m of elevated pedestrian walkway.

This project is part of Lord Mayor Graham Quirk's commitment for Brisbane City Council to provide \$120 million in new bikeway infrastructure over four years.

This stage of the upgrade is jointly funded by Brisbane City Council and the Queensland Government.
