RE: Stanley Street Footpath Closure

In response to the information provided by the Abigroup on the 12 August 2010, I advise that Council will not support the full closure of the Stanley Street footpath as requested. Council recognises the significance of the Queensland Children's Hospital Project however it is Council's responsibility to balance the needs of both the community and development. Safe and accessible pedestrian/cycle movement is to be maintained during the proposed construction.

Council will support the following:

1. Closure of the Stanley Street signalised pedestrian crossing (located on site frontage);
2. Work zone in Stanley Street (in the approximate location of the current bus zone);
3. Recommend pedestrian diversion on site during service relocation & footpath works;
4. Footpath access for pedestrians and cyclists (dismount) at a minimum width of 2.5m with the use of hoarding and gantry.
5. Scaffolding above gantry for construction of building projections into road reserve;
6. Temporary Closure from time to time during crane lifts, unloading/loading (no greater than 24hrs).

This will be outlined in the meeting scheduled for 9am, 26 September 2010 in the Brisbane Square Development Lounge. Please contact me if you have any queries regarding this matter.
