



## South Brisbane pedestrian and cycle pathway upgrade Construction works advance notification

The following works will take place between Monday 7 February and Sunday 20 February 2011 (weather permitting).

14 February – 20 February	Peel Street and Montague Road	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Line marking. To minimise disruption to pathway users, this work will be completed at night</li></ul>

### Flood update

Construction activities recommenced after the Christmas break on 4 January 2011 and continued until 12 January 2011 when heavy rain and flooding stopped work. The construction site was inundated and signage washed away. Work on this project has been delayed.

### TRAFFIC AND COMMUNITY IMPACTS

- Construction works will occur between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Saturday. It is also likely that some construction work will need to be undertaken on Sundays and at night.
- For the duration of the Kurilpa Park works cyclists will be required to use an alternative on-road route via Montague Road. Please travel carefully.
- Pedestrian access through the park will be maintained during daylight hours only. Pedestrians are advised to use an alternative route via the footpath on Montague Road after dusk.
- Pedestrians are to follow the directions on signage at all times and to proceed with caution through the construction zone.
