



## Bicentennial bikeway – Hale Street east upgrade Project Construction works advance notification

The following works will take place between Monday 19 September and Saturday 1 October 2011 (weather permitting).

### TRAFFIC AND COMMUNITY IMPACTS

- Construction on the Bicentennial Bikeway - Hale Street east project will occur **Monday to Saturday**. Where possible works will occur during normal construction hours of **6am and 6pm**, however due to the nature and location of the works Council's contractors will require **24 hour access** to the site.
- Night activities will include removal of excavated material from site and concreting works. Properties in close proximity may experience some construction noise and increased lighting.
- The Bicentennial Bikeway – Hale Street east upgrade is expected to be complete in early 2012, weather permitting.
- During construction, the Bicentennial Bikeway will be closed to all users between the Go Between Bridge and the Makerston Street exit at North Quay.
- All bikeway users must seek alternative routes for the duration of the works. Suggested alternative routes:
  - **travelling from the city towards Toowong** - exit at the Ann street ramp and follow detour signs
  - **travelling from Toowong towards the city** - travel across the Go Between Bridge and follow detour signs.
- Lane closures will also be required on Coronation Drive to ensure the safe delivery of materials to site and during some stormwater rectification works along the river side of Coronation Drive. To minimise the impact of these closures to on-road users the closures will be limited to a maximum of two lanes and will occur between the hours **9pm and 5am Sunday to Thursday**.
- Advance notification of particularly noisy works or major access changes will be provided to properties within the works area.
- **Cycle traffic speed on the detour routes is reduced to 10km/h for the duration of the work. Safety is our number one priority. Please travel carefully.**
