BICENTENNIAL BIKEWAY

Hale Street west upgrade project

Change of access from 27 January 2010

Construction work on the Bicentennial Bikeway, between Graham Street and the Go Between Bridge, has recommenced. Work on this section of the bikeway is expected to be completed by April 2011, weather permitting.

The Cribb Street underpass will be closed from Thursday 27 January 2011 until project work is complete.

While this work is being completed, pedestrians and cyclists are asked to observe the change of access signs and follow instructions given by traffic controllers.

Pedestrians and roller bladers

Pedestrians and roller bladers must use the footpath on the Milton side of Coronation Drive at all times.

Cyclists

- From Thursday 27 January 2011, the temporary side track will be available for use between **5am and 8pm**. Cyclists will be managed by traffic controllers and can expect delays of up to five minutes.
- The temporary side track will be closed between **8pm and 5am**. Cyclists will need to use the footpath on the Milton side of Coronation Drive - or find an alternative route.
- As construction vehicles need to access the Bicentennial Bikeway via the **Cribb Street ramp**, access will be managed by traffic controllers and police between 5am and 8pm.

For safety, please comply with the instructions of traffic controllers at all times.

Improvements have been made to the footpath on the Milton Road side of Coronation Drive and the road crossing at the intersection of Coronation Drive and Cribb Street to increase capacity and improve safety for both pedestrians and cyclists.

Council thanks you for your patience as we undertake this important work.

The Bicentennial Bikeway Hale Street west upgrade involves widening a 250m section of the bikeway between Cribb Street and the Go Between Bridge to construct a dedicated 3.5m wide cycle path and a 2.5m wide pedestrian path. On completion, the project will increase capacity and improve safety for cyclists and pedestrians.
