

## Bicentennial bikeway – Hale Street west upgrage Project Construction works advance notification

The following works will take place between Monday 7 February and Saturday 19 February 2011 (weather permitting).

7 – 12 February	Along the bikeway between Graham Street to the Go Between Bridge	<ul> <li>Concreting works between the Cribb Street underpass and the Go Between Bridge.</li> <li>Constructing footings for the retaining wall at the river side entrance to the Cribb Street underpass.</li> </ul>
14 - 19 February	Along the bikeway between Graham Street to the Go Between Bridge	<ul> <li>Micro piling works between the Cribb Street ramp and the Cribb Street underpass. This work will be undertaken at night.</li> <li>Constructing footings for the retaining wall at the river side entrance to the Cribb Street underpass.</li> <li>Constructing a retaining wall alongside the Cribb Street underpass.</li> </ul>

- Until mid-2011 the Bicentennial Bikeway will be closed between Graham Street and the Go Between Bridge. Construction work will be undertaken from 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.
- Due to the restricted work area, it is likely that work will be undertaken on Sundays and at night.
- Pedestrians (including people in wheel chairs, with prams, on roller blades or scooters) must exit the Bicentennial Bikeway at Graham Street, Milton or the Go Between Bridge and use the Coronation Drive footpath (Milton Road side) at all times.
- Cyclists must:
  - use the temporary side track between 5am and 8pm. This side track will maintain access during the day. Due to its limited width the side track has to one-way contra flow traffic management.
     Controllers will be onsite to manage cyclists and delays of up to five minutes can be expected during peak periods
  - exit the Bicentennial Bikeway at Graham Street, Milton or the Go Between Bridge and use an alternative route between 8pm and 5am.
- Pedestrians, roller bladers and cyclists are to follow the direction of traffic controllers at all times and are asked to proceed with caution through the construction zone.
- Cycle traffic speed through the construction zone is reduced to 10km/h for the duration of the work. Safety is our number one priority. Please travel carefully.
- Advance notification of particularly noisy works or major access changes will be provided to properties within the works area.
