

Bicentennial bikeway – Hale Street west upgrade project Construction works advance notification

The following works will take place between Monday 15 August and Saturday 27 August 2011 (weather permitting).

Changes to detour route

The scaffold side track has now been removed and cyclists have been diverted along a portion of the new section of bikeway between 5am – 8pm. Until the project is complete the site will remain closed between 8pm and 5am. For safety reasons, pedestrians will continue to use the alternative route along the footpath on Coronation Drive until all construction works are completed in late August. Council will send an update to advise when the project is complete.

TRAFFIC AND COMMUNITY IMPACTS

- The Bicentennial Bikeway will be closed between Graham Street and the Go Between Bridge until late August 2011, weather permitting. Construction work will be undertaken from 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.
- Due to the restricted work area, it is likely that work will be undertaken on Sundays and at night.
- Pedestrians (including people in wheel chairs, with prams, on roller blades or scooters) must exit the Bicentennial Bikeway at Graham Street, Milton or the Go Between Bridge and use the Coronation Drive footpath (Milton Road side) at all times.
- Cyclists must:
 - travel carefully through the site between 5am and 8pm. Due to its limited width the area has traffic management. Traffic controllers will be onsite to manage cyclists and delays of up to five minutes can be expected during peak periods.
 - exit the Bicentennial Bikeway at Graham Street, Milton or the Go Between Bridge and use an alternative route between 8pm and 5am.
- Pedestrians, roller bladers and cyclists are to follow the direction of traffic controllers at all times and are asked to proceed with caution in and around the construction zone.
- Cycle traffic speed through the construction zone is reduced to 10km/h for the duration of the work. Safety is our number one priority. Please travel carefully.
- Advance notification of particularly noisy works or major access changes will be provided to properties within the works area.
